Summer in Dorset Beach School Date (High Tide & Low Tide times and heights) Max 6 participants

Introduction:

Based on the book 'Tom & Lucy at the Seaside' by Shirley Hughes. In this Beach School session, the participants will carry out some of the activities Lucy and Tom do when they visited the beach.

Task:

Participants to carry out as many of the following activities as they choose:

- Making sandcastles this can be a small settlement or a larger castle. Stones/shells/seaweed etc. can be used to decorate the castle(s)
- Beach Art create a sand sculpture or make a picture using beach materials. In the story, Lucy creates a face.
- Create a vehicle, such as a speed boat or a car. In the story, Tom makes himself a speed boat.
- > Writing in the sand. The children can write their names or a message in the sand using a stick or stone.
