Maintaining social distance at drop off and pick up: higher risk of infection spread if social distancing not maintained	Leader, Volunteer, Participants Parents/carers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Group kept to a maximum of 6 participants and 2 adults. • Meeting point away from beach, with adequate space for family groups to socially distance from each other • Parents/carers, participants and other adults reminded to maintain social distance at all times 	All adults and participants to take some responsibility for maintaining social distancing
Maintaining social distance during activity: higher risk of infection spread if social distancing not maintained	Leader, Volunteer, Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Group size limited to a maximum of 8 (see above). • Activities do not need participants or adults to compromise social distancing and do not involve any shared equipment. • Adults briefed in advance and sent clear instructions for each activity (and social distancing) so they know what to do. • Total activity time restricted to 120 minutes 	All adults and participants to take some responsibility for maintaining social distancing
Hygiene of people: higher risk of infection spread if proper hand washing not carried out	Leader, Volunteer, Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compulsory use of hand sanitiser at beginning and end of session • Hand sanitiser used during session as appropriate depending on activity e.g before and after using any equipment 	Vigilance of adults to ensure all participants sanitise their hand thoroughly
Hygiene of activity equipment: Higher risk of infection spread if hygiene not carried out	Leader, Volunteer, Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equipment should not need to be shared. • If individuals want to swap equipment, they will be sanitised before exchange. 	Vigilance of adults to ensure equipment is not swapped. Responsibility of participants to only use

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			their designated equipment
Use of outdoor spaces: un-even ground, access to space less controlled, cannot be cleaned	Leader, Volunteer, Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beach is uneven and in use by the general public. • Area we will be working in will be marked off with Sports cones. • Boundary of area will be shown to all participants. • All of area can be seen. 	
Injury during activities	Leader, Volunteer, Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Risk assessment for all activities undertaken prior to activity taking place. • If any First Aid needs to be administered, First Aider will wear PPE 	PPE – Mask, gloves, apron and hand sanitiser to be kept with First Aid kit First Aider aware of how to put on and remove PPE
Post event infection	Leader, Volunteer, Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register kept of all participants for 21 days 	
Cross infection	Leader, Volunteer, Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adults to wash hand thoroughly between morning and afternoon sessions
