Rope injury - burn or entrapment	Leaders, Volunteers, Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leader experienced in the physical area visiting • Purpose of using rope and string explained. • Some of the injuries caused by rope and string explained, such as burns and cutting circulation. Information given as to how these can be avoided – working carefully and slowly and ensuring fingers are not trapped in knots. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leader competence approved
Splinters	Leaders, Volunteers, Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If using driftwood, check for splinters 	
Back Strain	Leaders, Volunteers, Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Encouraged not to move large stones or driftwood. • If large items required, group to work together to move item. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leader makes ongoing assessments at start and during activity
